

ORDER OF THE NURSING HOME ADMINISTRATOR  
EXAMINING BOARD AMENDING RULES

Pursuant to authority vested in the Nursing Home Administrator Examining Board by Section 456.02, Wis. Stats., the Nursing Home Administrator Examining Board hereby amends and adopts rules as follows:

NHA 3.02 - Approval of programs study - section (3) CONTINUING EDUCATION - add:

"(d) The Board shall determine the continuing education hours value of program clock hours, this determination shall be based on an analysis of program clock hours submitted. Programs that provide substantial education in long-term care administration may receive additional value in establishing assigned continuing education hours."

NHA 4.02 - Registration of Licenses -

(2) is amended to read:

"Upon making application for new certificates of renewal, such licensee shall pay an annual registration fee not to exceed \$50., and, at the same time, shall submit evidence satisfactory to the Board that during the annual period immediately preceding such application, that he had attended a minimum of 12 hours of continuing education or course of study as provided in section NHA 3.02(3) of these rules and regulations."
