ORDER OF THE STATE OF WISCONSIN NATURAL RESOURCES BOARD AMENDING AND CREATING RULES

Pursuant to authority vested in the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board by Sections 23.09, 29.085, 29.174, 29.33 and 227.02, Wisconsin Statutes, the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board hereby amends and creates rules as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter NR 20.17 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is amended to read:

NR 20.17. REPORT OF LICENSED GUIDES. All Wisconsin guides licensed under the provisions of Section 29.165, Wisconsin Statutes, and operating in the Wisconsin waters of Lake Superior, Lake Michigan and Green Bay shall report to the department on blanks to be furnished by the department detailed information regarding their fishing activities which shall include the quantity, the varieties of fish taken, and any other information pertaining to their fishing activities required by the department.

SECTION 2. Chapter NR 25.02 (10) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is created to read:

NR 25.02 (10). No nets of any kind shall be used, set, placed or operated in that portion of southern Green Bay lying north or east of a line commencing at the end of Ogden Street in the city of Marinette and running southeasterly to the

most southwesterly point of Seagull Bar, thence along the shoreline of Seagull Bar to the public boat landing located in section 16, T30N, R24E, Marinette county.

SECTION 3. Chapter NR 25.04 (1)(c) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is amended to read:

NR 25.04 (1). OPEN SEASONS.

SECTION 4. Chapter NR 25.05 (1)(a) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is amended to read:

NR 25.05. ILLEGAL FISH.

(1)(a). All illegal fish caught in nets which cannot be returned alive or unharmed to the water shall be tagged with tags furnished by the department of natural resources as soon as possible after removal from the water. Such tags shall remain attached to the fish until prepared for final consumption, and no such fish or part thereof other than offal shall be transported in any manner without such tag or tags attached thereto.

SECTION 5. Chapter NR 25.08 (3)(c) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is created to read:

NR 25.08 (3)(c). During the closed season for whitefish, no pound nets of any kind shall be used, set, placed or operated in the waters of Lake Michigan, northern Green Bay or southern Green Bay except under permit.

SECTION 6. Chapter NR 25.08 (5)(e) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is amended to read:

NR 25.08 (5)(e). Submarine trap nets shall not be used, set, placed or operated in the waters of southern Green Bay during the period of April 10 to May 19 of each year, or in the waters of southern Green Bay, Lake Michigan and northern Green Bay during the closed season for whitefish except under permit.

SECTION 7. Chapter NR 25.20 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is amended to read:

NR 25.20. ICING AND REFRIGERATION. It shall be unlawful from April 15 to September 30 of each year for any person holding a license to conduct commercial fishing operations on any of the outlying waters pursuant to Section 29.33, Wisconsin Statutes, to conduct such fishing operations with a boat unless he carries on such boat a supply of ice sufficient to properly ice and chill all such fish taken for human consumption, or unless such boat is adequately equipped with mechanical refrigeration to properly chill all fish taken for human consumption.

SECTION 8. Chapter NR 25.22 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is amended to read:

NR 25.22. POSSESSION OF FISHING EQUIPMENT.

(1). No person except licensed commercial fishermen and authorized net dealers shall have in his possession or under his control at any time any trammel, gill or hoop net or any other kind of net, nets, or fish trap that might take, catch or kill fish in Ashland, Bayfield, Douglas or Iron counties, except minnow nets and minnow traps, whitefish and cisco nets, dip nets, pound nets, crab traps and turtle traps as provided by board order, unless such nets are sealed with locking seals by the department.

SECTION 9. Chapter NR 25.22 (2) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is created to read:

NR 25.22 (2). No person shall have in his possession in or on the waters of Lake Michigan or Green Bay any gill nets with a mesh greater than 2-3/4 inch stretch measure unless he has first obtained and has on his person a valid permit for the use of such nets and is in or on the waters designated in his permit.

The foregoing rules and regulations were approved at the December 20, 1973 meeting of the Natural Resources Board, and will take effect upon publication.
