ORDER OF THE EXAMINING BOARD OF ARCHITECTS, PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERS, DESIGNERS, AND LAND SURVEYORS ADOPTING RULES

Pursuant to authority vested in the Examining Board of Architects,
Professional Engineers, Designers and Land Surveyors by Sections 15.08(5)
and 443.01, Wis. Stats., the Examining Board hereby adopts rules to read
as follows:

Sections A-E 1.15(4)(e)1. and A-E 1.15(4)(f) are created to read:

- (e) Academic and experience requirements for entrance to "equivalency examination."
 - A candidate for registration as an architect shall be admitted to the equivalency examination if the candidate has 4 years of acceptable academic credit or a combination of academic credit and architectural work experience which totals 4 years.
- (f) Requirements for entrance to "professional examination." A candidate for registration as an architect shall be admitted to the professional examination if the candidate has either obtained a degree in architecture accredited by the National Architectural Accrediting Board or has successfully completed the equivalency examination.

The rules, amendments, and repeals contained herein shall take effect on the first day of the month following their publication in the Wisconsin Administrative Code.
