ORDER OF THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE ADOPTING RULES

Pursuant to authority vested in the Department of Agriculture by Sections 93.07(1) and (10), and Chapter 95, Wis. Stats., the State of Wisconsin Department of Agriculture hereby adopts rules as follows:

Chapter Ag 11

LIVESTOCK DEALERS AND MARKETS

1. Section Ag 11.03(2) of the Wis. Admin. Code is created to read: Ag 11.03(2) CALF MOVEMENT. No operator of a livestock market shall permit calves under 12 weeks of age to be held on the premises longer than 24 hours after the point of sale.

2. Section Ag 11.05 of the Wis. Admin. Code is created to read: Ag 11.05 <u>Calf movement by dealer and market operator</u>. Each dealer and each market operator purchasing calves under 12 weeks of age at a livestock market shall remove them from the premises within 24 hours after purchase.

The rules contained herein shall take effect as provided in Section 227.026, Wis. Stats.
