

ORDER OF THE STATE OF WISCONSIN NATURAL RESOURCES BOARD

RENUMBERING AND AMENDING RULES

Pursuant to the authority vested in the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board by section 29.174 (3) and Chapter 227, Wisconsin Statutes, the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board hereby renumbers and amends as follows:

Shotgun season:

There shall be an open season for hunting deer with smoothbore, muzzle-loading muskets of not less than .45 caliber, rifled muzzle-loading muskets of not less than .40 caliber, and shotguns loaded with single slug or ball, in described zones during the period designated "shotgun season".

In all portions of the state not otherwise listed in the following described season zones, "B" through "G".


The foregoing rules were approved and adopted by the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board on May 17, 1974.


