

ORDER OF

DEPARTMENT OF INDUSTRY, LABOR AND HUMAN RELATIONS

Pursuant to authority vested in the Department of Industry, Labor and Human Relations by sections 101.01 to 101.20, Wis. Stats., the Department of Industry, Labor and Human Relations hereby amend, repeals and recreates and adopts rules of Wisconsin Administrative Code Chapters Ind 41-42-- Boiler and Pressure Vessel Code.

The rules attached hereto shall become effective on the first day of the month following publication in the Wisconsin Administrative Code as provided in Section 227, Wis. Stats.

Section Ind 41.03 "Note" is created to read:

NOTE: To assure proper installation, alteration, or repair of a boiler or pressure vessel, it may be necessary to comply with applicable Wisconsin Administrative Code Sections in addition to the Wisconsin Boiler and Pressure Vessel Code.

Some of the Wisconsin Code sections to be considered are as follows:

Section Ind 59.59 (Combustion Air Intake Requirements)

- " Ind 52.11 (Metal Smoke Stack Requirements)
- " Ind 54.13, 55.29, 56.15, & 57.20 (Boiler Room Requirements)
- " Ind 69.01 (Fee Schedule)
- " Ind 59.63(1) (Safety Fuel Burners)

Section Ind 41.10 to be repealed and recreated to read:

Ind 41.10 Adoption of Standards

- (1) The standards, amendments and errata issued by the American Society of Mechanical Engineers as listed in table 41.10-A are hereby incorporated by reference into this code.
- (2) Pursuant to section 227.025, Wisconsin Statutes, consent has been granted to incorporate by reference the rules contained in the standards, amendments and errata listed in Table 41.10-A.
