ORDER OF THE STATE OF WISCONSIN NATURAL RESOURCES BOARD REPEALING AND AMENDING RULES

Pursuant to the authority vested in the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board by section 29.174 (3) and Chapter 227, Wisconsin Statutes, the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board hereby repeals and amends rules as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter NR 10.01 (3) (f) is amended to read:

Kind of animal and locality

Open season (both dates inclusive) Bag limit

- (f) Fox, all species
- 1. Hunting and trapping season

SECTION 2. Chapter NR 10.06 (3) is amended to read:

(3) It shall be unlawful for any person to hunt or shoot any deer and bear during the open season on any day during the open season before the time listed in the a.m. column, and after the time listed in the p.m. column in the following table:

SECTION 3. Chapter NR 10.201 (1) is amended to read:

NR 10.201 Recording of Wildcat (Bobcat). (1) Each person who has killed a wildcat (bobcat) by hunting or trapping during the established open season shall exhibit each animal to an authorized representative of the DNR in the county in which such animal was taken, or in an adjoining county within 5 days of such taking. Said representatives shall inspect the animal and attach and lock a special tag indicating it has been inspected. It shall be unlawful for any person

to possess raw pelts from such animals beginning 6 days after the close of the season to the opening date of the following season without such tag attached and locked. No person shall transfer, give, trade, sell, or purchase any such pelts without such tag being attached and locked to the head of each pelt. This section shall not apply to wildcat taken outside of the state of Wisconsin.

SECTION 4. Chapter NR 10.22 (2) (b) is amended to read:

(b) Permits for hunting waterfowl, squirrels, and ruffed grouse only shall be issued. Waterfowl hunting will be permitted only from the opening date of the general duck season through the Sunday immediately prior to the opening day of the deer gun season with bag limits the same as those that apply in the remainder of Wood county. Squirrel and ruffed grouse hunting will be permitted only during the same period open for waterfowl hunting. The daily bag limit on squirrels and ruffed grouse shall be the same as for the remainder of Wood county.

SECTION 5. Chapter NR 10.27 (2) is amended to read:

(2) Gun season and December bow and arrow season only: Rock Island state park, Newport state park, Big Bay state park recreation area, Lake Wissota state park recreation area, Tuscobia-Park Falls state trail, Elroy-Sparta state trail, Mirror Lake state park recreation area; Hartman Creek state park, Devil's Lake state park, Interstate state park, Wildcat Mountain state park and Willow River state park.

Section 35 - Entire section north of Chicago, Burlington and Quincy Railroad Township 24 north, range 13 west, town of Maxwell

Section 30 - W 1/2 of the SW 1/4

Section 31 - All that part lying west of state highway 25

Township 24 north, range 14 west, town of Maxwell

Section 23 - All those parts of Government Lots 2 and 3 lying east of the Chicago, Milwaukee, St. Paul and Pacific Railroad

Section 24 - Government Lots 12 and 13

Section 25 - Government Lots 3, 4, 5, 6, 9, 10, 11 and 12

Section 26 - All that part lying east of the Chicago, Milwaukee, St. Paul and Pacific Railroad

Section 35 - All that part lying east of the Chicago, Milwaukee, St. Paul and Pacific Railroad

Section 36 - Entire Section

SECTION 7. Chapter NR 10.14 (1) is repealed.

NR 10.14 Trapping, prohibited methods
