ORDER OF THE STATE OF WISCONSIN NATURAL RESOURCES BOARD

AMENDING AND CREATING RULES

Pursuant to authority vested in the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board by sections 29.085, 29.174, 23.09 and 227.02, Wis. Stats., the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board hereby amends and creates rules as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter NR 10.01 (2) (a) is amended to read:

NR 10.01 (2)

SECTION 5. Chapter NR 10.01 (4) (a) 2. is amended to read:

NR 10.01 (4) (a)

2. All that part of the state lying southerly of state highway 64 and northerly of the line beginning at the junctions of U. S. highway 18 with the western boundary of the state, thence easterly along said highway 18 to its junction with U. S. highway 51, thence northerly along said Highway 51 to its junction with state highway 60, thence easterly along said highway 60 to its junction with Ozaukee county highway "Q" extended easterly to Lake Michigan except that part of Dodge county lying northerly of state highway 60, and Fond du Lac, Outagamie, Waupaca, Waushara and Winnebago counties

Beginning on the Saturday nearest November 1 and continuing through December 31 (water sets permitted) None

SECTION 6. Chapter NR 10.09 (4) is amended to read:

NR 10.09

(4) During the 24-hour period prior to the opening date for hunting deer with firearms, no person shall have in possession any firearm in any area wherein there is an open season for deer with firearms, unless the firearm is unloaded and enclosed within a carrying case, except that target shooting at established ranges shall be permitted and waterfowl hunters shall be permitted to hunt waterfowl continually during the open season and hunting on licensed game farms and shooting preserves shall be permitted.

SECTION 7. Chapter NR 10.13 (3) is amended to read:

NR 10.13

(3) The trapping hours shall be from 6:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. (CST) and it shall be unlawful for any person to set or reset any trap or traps or attend any trapline from 7:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m. (CST). All dry land sets shall be checked and animals therein removed at least once each day.

SECTION 8. Chapter NR 10.14 (5) is created to read:

NR 10.14

(5) It shall be unlawful for any person to set, place or operate any steel jaw trap with a spread width of more than 8 inches.


The foregoing rules were approved and adopted by the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board on January 24, 1975.

The rules contained herein shall take effect upon publication.


