

ORDER OF

DEPARTMENT OF INDUSTRY, LABOR AND HUMAN RELATIONS

Pursuant to authority vested in the Department of Industry, Labor and Human Relations by section 101.01-101.20, Wis. Stats., the Department of Industry, Labor and Human Relations hereby amends and adopts rules of Wisconsin Administrative Code Section Ind 72.085, Independent Colleges and Universities.

Section Ind 72.085 is created to read:

Ind 72.085 Independent Colleges and Universities.

- (1) Independent colleges and universities may employ full-time students 18 years of age and over 20 hours per week at the following rates.
July 1, 1975, \$1.70 per hour; January 1, 1976, \$1.87 per hour;
January 1, 1977, \$1.96 per hour.
- (2) All hours worked over 20 hours per week must be paid for at the rates established under Section Ind 72.03.

The rule contained herein shall become effective on the first day of the month following publication in the Wisconsin Administrative Code as provided in Section 227, Wis. Stats.
