ORDER OF THE STATE OF WISCONSIN NATURAL RESOURCES BOARD

REPEALING, AMENDING, REPEALING AND RECREATING AND CREATING RULES

Pursuant to authority vested in the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board by sections 29.085, 29.174, 23.09 and 227.02, Wisconsin Statutes, the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board hereby repeals, amends, repeals and recreates and creates rules as follows:

SECTION 1 - NR 10.001 is created to read:

NR 10.001 Definition (1) "Department" means the department of natural resources.

SECTION 2 - NR 10.01 (3) (e) 7. is amended to read:

SECTION 3 - NR 10.01 (3) (e) 8. is repealed and recreated to read:

8. Deer quotas for 1975 deer season. The department will issue party permits in sufficient numbers to assure the harvest of the number of deer for each quota area indicated in the following table. Quota areas are composed of single management units or parts of units, the boundaries of which are established in Wis. Adm. Code section NR 10.24. The number of party permits to be issued to harvest the indicated number of deer is determined by an average of the hunter success rates from the most recent 3 previous seasons with party permits in each quota area or by an average of fewer seasons where a 3-year average is not available. In establishing a quota for an area without a prior history of party permits, the average success rates of adjacent quota areas are applied. Party permit success rates used to compute the number of permits to be issued for each management unit are those published by the department in annual deer season reports.

SECTION 4 - NR 10.01 (4) (c) and (d) are amended to read:

(c) Beaver. It is unlawful for any person to take in any zone more than the season bag limit established for such zone and it is unlawful for any person to take more than a total combined season bag limit of 50 beaver in all the open season zones in the state.

(d) Otter. There is no open season for otter in Zone C and Adams county. In all other zones, the opening date for the trapping season for otter shall be concurrent with the opening date for trapping beaver in all zones established under paragraph (c) of the section. The open season for trapping otter in all zones shall extend through the last day of the beaver season specified for zone A. The season bag limit is 2 otter in zones A and B and one otter in zone D. It is unlawful for any person to take more than a total combined season bag limit of 2 otter in all the open season zones in the state. Each person who has trapped an otter will affix to such carcass immediately upon trapping a tag issued by the department. Upon request such tags will be issued free of charge by the State of Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources, Box 450, Madison, Wisconsin 53701.

SECTION 5 - NR 10.06 (3) is amended to read:

(3) It shall be unlawful for any person to hunt or shoot any deer and bear during the open season on any day during the open season before the time listed in the a.m. column, and after the time listed in the p.m. column in the following table:

SECTION 6 - NR 10.07 (7) (a) is amended to read:

(a) No person shall use or have in his possession or under his control any ferret while hunting, except as provided in this subsection. The owner or occupant of any land where rabbits are found to be doing damage may request from the department a permit to use a ferret for hunting rabbits thereon.

SECTION 7 - NR 10.16 is amended to read:

(4) An open season for hunting wild turkeys as listed in Wis. Adm. Code section NR 10.01 (2) (f) is established on the Necedah national wildlife refuge,

and such season shall be concurrent with the open season for hunting turkeys as described in section NR 10.01 (2) (f). Such open season shall be effective only in those areas on the Necedah national wildlife refuge designated by posted notices of the U.S. fish and wildlife service. Hunting on the Necedah national wildlife refuge shall be restricted to only those persons holding a valid principal or guest turkey hunting permit issued by the department.

SECTION 8 - NR 11.27 (15) is repealed.

SECTION 9 - NR 15.01 (48) (b) and (c) is repealed.

SECTION 10 - NR 15.01 (49) (a), (b) and (c) are created to read:


SECTION 11 - NR 15.01 (69) (b), (c), (d) and (f) are repealed.

The rules contained herein shall take effect upon publication.


