ORDER OF THE PHARMACY INTERNSHIP BOARD
ADOPTING AND AMENDING RULES

Pursuant to authority vested in the Pharmacy Internship Board by section 15.08(5) and according to the procedure set forth in section 227.02(1)(b) Wis. Stats., the Pharmacy Internship Board hereby adopts the rules as follows:

Section Ph-Int 1.02(6) of the WISCONSIN ADMINISTRATIVE CODE is amended to read:


(6) The internship application is to be accompanied by a registration fee of \$10.00.

Section Ph-Int 1.02(7) of the WISCONSIN ADMINISTRATIVE CODE is amended to read:

(7) Registration as an intern expires on July 31 in the year succeeding the year in which the registration fee was recorded, unless revoked, suspended, or cancelled.

The rules and amendments contained herein shall take effect on January 1, 1976.
