**ORDER ADOPTING EMERGENCY RULE
UNDER 227.02 (1) (c) and 227.027, WIS. STATS.,
WITHOUT NOTICE AND PUBLIC HEARING
IN THE MATTER OF ADOPTING AN EMER-
GENCY RULE RELATING TO FEES FOR SPECIAL
HANDLING UNDER CHAPTER 39, LAWS OF 1975**

Pursuant to authority vested in the Division of Motor Vehicles of the Wisconsin Department of Transportation under 110.06, and more specifically 341.255 and 342.14 (7), Wis. Stats., as created in Chapter 39, Laws of 1975, the Division finds that an emergency exists and that the emergency rule included below is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public welfare.

A statement of the facts constituting the emergency is as follows: Chapter 39, Laws of 1975, provided that the Division shall charge a fee to be established by rule for processing applications for certificates of title or registrations which have a special handling request for fast service. In order to permit the Division to promptly implement the service, and for the public to take advantage of this special service, it is necessary to adopt an emergency rule.

The rules are therefore adopted as emergency rules to take effect on October 1, 1975, and upon filing with the Secretary of State and the Revisor of Statutes as provided in Section 227.027, Wis. Stats.

(1) A fee of \$4.00 shall be charged for processing each application for a certificate of title and/or registration plates received by mail that includes a request for fast service.

(2) A fee of \$4.00 shall be charged for fast service processing of each application for certificate of title and/or registration plates which was recently submitted without a request for fast service.

(3) A fee of \$4.00 shall be charged for fast service processing of each application for a certificate of title at the Madison or Milwaukee registration counters.

Chapter MVD 26

FEE SCHEDULES FOR SPECIAL HANDLING SERVICES

MVD 26.01 Fees for Special Handling Requests for Fast Service

MVD 26.01 Fees. The following fees shall be charged for processing applications for vehicle certificates of title or registration when the applicant requests prompt issuance of the title or registration, and such service requires exceptional processing procedures:

(1) A fee of \$4.00 shall be charged for processing each application for a certificate of title, or registration received by mail that includes a request for fast service.

(2) A fee of \$4.00 shall be charged for each request for fast service processing of each application for a certificate of title or registration originally submitted without a request for fast service.

(3) A fee of \$4.00 shall be charged for fast service processing of each application for a certificate of title at the Madison or Milwaukee registration counters.

(4) A fee of \$2.00 for the prompt processing of each renewal registration application, or each original reciprocity, proration or tax application submitted by the same owner or lessee, and such application is part of a group of more than six applications requiring the use of exceptional processing procedures.
