IN THE MATTER of amending NR 1.43(3) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code pertaining to acquisition of fish and game lands

ORDER OF THE STATE OF WISCONSIN NATURAL RESOURCES BOARD AMENDING RULES

Pursuant to authority vested in the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board by section 23.09 and chapters 29 and 227, Wisconsin Statutes, the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board hereby amends rules as follows:

SECTION 1 - NR 1.43 (3) is amended to read:

(3) The boundaries of all land acquisition projects involving water frontage shall extend a distance of a minimum of 150 feet from the shoreline, except for perpendicular access or where narrower strips of land will provide adequate access and habitat protection due to specific physical conditions, such as the presence of roads, favorable topography or land use conditions.

The foregoing rules were approved and adopted by the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board on January 22, 1976.

The rules contained herein shall take effect upon publication.
