

ORDER OF THE STATE OF WISCONSIN NATURAL RESOURCES BOARD

AMENDING, REPEALING & RECREATING AND CREATING RULES

Pursuant to the authority vested in the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board by section 144.31 and chapter 227, Wisconsin Statutes, the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board hereby amends, repeals and recreates, and creates rules as follows:

SECTION 1 - NR 154.11 (4) (a) 1. a. is amended to read:

a. Installations of 250 million BTU per hour or less: 0.15 pounds of particulate matter per million BTU to any stack.

SECTION 2 - NR 154.11 (4) (b) 3. (intro. par.) is amended to read:

3. Installations located in the Southeast Wisconsin Intrastate AQCR; in addition to meeting the emission limits of (4)(b)1.a. of this section by July 31, 1975, these installations shall by July 1, 1976 submit a plan and implementation schedule acceptable to the department for meeting the following requirements as expeditiously as possible:

SECTION 3 - NR 154.11 (4) (b) 3. a. is repealed and recreated to read:

a. Installations of 250 million BTU per hour or less (heat input of an installation shall follow ASME standard number APS-1); maximum emission defined by the equation, $E = 0.3 - 0.0006I$ where I is heat input in millions of BTU per hour and E is maximum allowable particulate emissions in pounds per million

BTU to any stack. Installations with maximum heat input less than one million BTU per hour shall not be required to meet particulate emission limits of NR 154.11(4). Installations located in areas which have not attained ambient air quality standards may be required to install best available control technology even though best available control technology might not be required to meet the emission limits established by the above equation.

SECTION 4 - NR 154.12 (2) (c) is created to read:

(c) In the Southeast Wisconsin Intrastate AQCR installations of 250 million BTU per hour or less (heat input of an installation shall follow ASME standard number APS-1) in addition to meeting the emission limits of s. NR 154.11(4), Wis. Adm. Code, shall not burn coal with a sulphur content exceeding 1.11 pounds per million BTU in the coal.

The foregoing rules were approved and adopted by the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board on December 18, 1975.

The rules contained herein shall take effect upon publication.
