

ORDER OF THE STATE OF WISCONSIN NATURAL RESOURCES BOARD

CREATING RULES

Pursuant to authority vested in the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board by section 147.04(2) and chapter 227, Wisconsin Statutes, the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board hereby creates rules as follows:

SECTION 1 - Chapter NR 217 is created to read:

Chapter NR 217

Effluent Limitations for
Uncategorized Point Sources

NR 217.01 Purpose

NR 217.10 Application of effluent limitations

NR 217.01 Purpose. The purpose of this chapter is to provide for the application of effluent limitations in permits for discharges from point sources which are not subject to the effluent limitations in Wis. Adm. Code chapters NR 221 to 299 inclusive.

NR 217.10 Application of effluent limitations. (1) The department may specify effluent limitations applicable in permits for the discharge from point sources:

(a) Which are not included in the classes or categories of point sources identified in Wis. Adm. Code chapter NR 220,

(b) Which belong to classes or categories of point sources for which effluent limitations have not been adopted in Wis. Adm. Code chapters NR 221 to 299 inclusive, or

(c) Which belong to classes or categories of point sources excluded from, or not specifically included in, the applicability provisions of the effluent limitations of Wis. Adm. Code chapters NR 221 to 299 inclusive.

(2) In permits for discharges from point sources identified in subsection (1) of this chapter effluent limitations shall be those which the department determines are achievable by the application of the best practicable control technology currently available, or, where appropriate, the best available control technology economically achievable.

(3) In making such determinations the department shall in part be guided, where appropriate, by transferrable technology identified in guideline development documents, published by the U.S. environmental protection agency pursuant to Public Law 92-500, as best practicable control technology currently available or best available control technology economically achievable and by effluent limitations achievable by such technologies as set forth in Wis. Adm. Code chapters NR 221 to 299 inclusive.

The foregoing rules were approved and adopted by the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board on January 22, 1976.

The rules contained herein shall take effect upon publication.
