

## ORDER OF THE STATE ELECTIONS BOARD ADOPTING RULES

Pursuant to the authority vested in the State Elections Board by section 227.014, Wis. Stats., the State Elections Board hereby adopts rules as follows:

Sections ElBd. 3.02 and 3.04 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code are adopted to read:

- 3.02 Mail Registration Forms. In accordance with sec. 6.30 (4), Stats., clerks shall, upon request, supply electors with a reasonable number of forms for registering eligible electors by mail. Refusal to supply forms in the quantity requested shall be accompanied by a statement to the elector of the reasons for said refusal.
- 3.04 Proof of Residence. A current library card or, a current university, college or technical institute identification card together with a current university, college or technical institute fee card bearing the student's local address shall constitute acceptable proof of residency, if the elector wishes to claim residency in that jurisdiction, for purposes of sec. 6.55, Stats.

The rules contained herein shall take effect on the first day of the month following their publication in the Wisconsin Administrative Register as prescribed in sec. 227.026 (1), Wis. Stats.
