

ORDER AMENDING RULES

ETHICS BOARD

AMENDING VARIOUS PROVISIONS OF THE ETHICS BOARD'S RULES FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELIMINATING DISTINCTIONS BASED UPON SEX AS DIRECTED BY SECTION 227.033, WISCONSIN STATUTES.

Pursuant to the authority vested in the State of Wisconsin Ethics Board by Chapter 227 and section 19.48(1), Wisconsin Statutes, and in accordance with section 227.033, Wisconsin Statutes, the Ethics Board amends the following rules:

Section Eth 1.02(1) is amended by adding "or her" after "his".

Section Eth 1.02(5) is amended by adding "or her" after "his".

Section Eth 1.03 is amended by substituting "the" for "his" in two places.

Section Eth 2.02 is amended by substituting "of taking" for "he takes" and adding "or she" after "he".

Section Eth 2.03(1) (intro.) is amended by substituting "of" for "he".

Section Eth 2.03(1)(a) is amended by substituting "filing" for "files".

Section Eth 2.03(2) is amended by substituting "the person's" for "his".

Section Eth 2.08 is amended by adding "or her" after "his".

Section Eth 3.10(2) (intro.) is amended by adding "or her" after "his".

Section Eth 3.10(2)(b) is amended by adding "or her" after "him" and adding "or her" after "his".

Section Eth 3.10(3) is amended as follows:

Eth 3.10(3) Executive director or his <u>or her</u> designee may not proceed under this section unless he-has-first-notified-in-writing the person or organization <u>has first been notified in writing of</u> the activities of which are the subject of the investigation, of the exact nature and purpose of the investigation, the specific actions or activities to be investigated, a statement of such person's due process rights and a copy of section 19.48, Wis. Stats.

Section Eth 3.13(1) is amended by substituting "chair" for "board's chairman".

Section Eth 3.14(1) is amended as follows:

Eth 3.14(1) Changes in the time and place of the first session of a hearing in any proceeding may be granted only by the beard's chairman chair, or presiding officer designated by the chairmanchair, for good cause shown by a written request made to the board's-chairman chair reasonably in advance of the time set, showing when and how copies of such requests were served upon each member of the board, the board's executive director, the complainant, and the respondent.

Section Eth 3.15(3) is amended by adding "or she" after "he".

Section Eth 3.17 is amended by deleting "his".

Section Eth 3.18(3)(a) is amended by adding "or her" after "him".

Section Eth 3.18(3)(b) is amended by substituting "the respondent" for "he" and adding "or her" after "his".

Section Eth 3.19(2)(b) is amended by substituting "the state public official or state public employe" for "him".

Section Eth 3.19(2)(c) is amended by substituting "the employe" for "him".

Section Eth 3.21 is amended by adding "or she" after "he".

Section Eth 3.30 is amended as follows:

Eth 3.30 Requests for written advice. In instances where delay is of substantial inconvenience or detriment to a party requesting the board's written advice regarding the propriety of any matter to which he or she is or may become a party, the board's executive director may, with the advice and consent of the ehairman chair, or if the-chairman he or she is unavailable with the advice and consent of the vice-chairman next ranking officer of the board, or if the-vice-chairman he or she is unavailable, with the advice and consent of the secretary or other member of the board, advise the state public official. Written advice prepared by the executive director pursuant to this rule shall have the full force and effect of written advice given by the board, except that at its next meeting, the board may rescind or modify that written advice.

Section Eth 6.02(2)(a) is amended by adding "or her" after "his" and substituting "to be inspected" for "he wishes to inspect".

Section Eth 6.03 is amended to read:

Eth 6.03 Access to statements of economic interests. Request to Copy. The executive director or his <u>or her</u> designee shall require each person wishing to obtain a copy of a statement of economic interests in the board's possession to identify himself or herself and, if he-represents representing another person or organization, the identity of the person or organization he represents represented. The board shall record and retain information obtained by it pursuant to this section.

The rules contained herein shall take effect as provided in section 227.026(1), Wisconsin Statutes.
