NR 11.06 Closed area; waterfowl. A closed season is established on the following described areas, and it is unlawful for any person to take, catch, kill, hunt, or pursue with the use of firearms or bow and arrow any species of wild animals or birds thereon during the periods established in Wis. Adm. Code section NR 10.01 (1) as open seasons on waterfowl.

(2) WAUPACA COUNTY. (a) *Partridge lake.*

Township 21 north, range 13 east, town of Weyauwega.

Section 14—south 10 acres of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, S $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, W $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$.

Section 23—NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, NW $\frac{1}{4}$.

(4) VILAS COUNTY. (a) *Helen lake.*

Township 43 north, range 9 east, town of Land O' Lakes.

Section 19—E $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$.

Section 20—SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ and NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$.

Section 30—NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, W $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, NW $\frac{1}{4}$, NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$.

(b) *Bay Beach.*

All that part of the city of Green Bay described as follows:

Beginning at a point where Diener Drive intersects the Fox River; thence east on Diener Drive to the junction of Nicolet Drive; thence easterly on Nicolet Drive to the east line of Bay Beach Park; thence north along the east line of Bay Beach Park to the shoreline of Green Bay, thence east along said shoreline to the center line of said section 28, township 24 north, range 21 east; thence north along extended

center line of section 28 to a point 300 feet north of water's edge of Green Bay; thence westerly on a line 300 feet north of water's edge of Green Bay to the center line of the Fox River; thence in a southeasterly direction to Diener Drive, place of beginning.

(6) WAHKESHA COUNTY. (a) *Vernon marsh*

Section 13—That portion of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ and the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ west of an existing dike and connecting access road and a strip 100 feet wide, parallel and west of said dike and access road; except the NWNW and the N $\frac{1}{2}$ NWSWNW

Section 14—The SE $\frac{1}{4}$ and E $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$; except the 2.6 parcel in the SE corner of said E $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$.

Section 23—The E $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ west of the Soo Line railroad right of way except the south 1,250 feet. The E $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, NENE, the south 400 feet of the NENW, and a 4-rod strip along the south line of the NWNW east of state trunk highway 83.

Section 24—That portion of said section lying west of the Soo Line railroad right of way and south of the Fox river.

NR 11.08 Closed area; waterfowl. A closed season is established in the following described areas, and it is unlawful for any person to take, catch, kill, hunt, trap, or pursue in any manner any species of wild animals or birds thereon during the periods established in Wis. Adm. Code section NR 10.01 (1) as open seasons on waterfowl.

(7) ROCK COUNTY. (a) *Rock county goose area.*

Township 2 north, range 14 east, town of Bradford.

All lands lying in section 1 including all that part of county highway "C" running along east line of said section, and including all that part of U.S. highway 14 running along south line of said section. All lands lying within E $\frac{1}{2}$ of section 2 including all that part of the town road running along west line of said E $\frac{1}{2}$, and including all that part of U.S. highway 14 running along south line of said E $\frac{1}{2}$. All that part of the town road running south through center of section 12 lying within 200 feet of north line of said section.

Township 3 north, range 14 east, town of Johnstown.

All lands lying within SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of section 35 including all that part of county highway "M" running along north line of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of said section, and including all that part of the town road running along west line of said quarter-section. All lands lying within S $\frac{1}{2}$ of section 36 including all that part of county highway "C" running along east line of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of

NR 11.33 Closed area; state trails. A closed season is established on the following described areas, and it is unlawful for any person to take, catch, kill, hunt, trap or pursue in any matter any species of wild animals or birds on such lands during the period from February 1 through the Friday preceding the Saturday nearest October 27, both dates inclusive.

(1) **GREEN COUNTY.** (a) *Sugar River state trail.* A strip of land 100 feet wide more or less, commencing in New Glarus and including the following descriptions:

1. T4N, R7E, village of New Glarus, Green county
 - a. Section 14—part of NESW, part of SESW, part of SWSE.
 - b. Section 23—part of NWNE, part of SWNE, part of NENW, part of NESE, part of NWSE, part of SESE.
 - c. Section 24—part of SWSW, part of SESW, part of SWSE, part of SESE.
 - d. Section 25—part of NENE.
2. T4N, R8E, town of Exeter, Green county.
 - a. Section 30—part of NWNE, part of SWNE, part of NENW, part of fr. W½ NW, part of NWSE, part of SWSE, part of SESE.
 - b. Section 31—part of NENE, part of NWNE, part of SENE, part of NESE, part of SESE.
3. T3N, R8E, town of Mount Pleasant, Green county.
 - a. Section 5—part of NWNW, part of SWNW, part of NWSW, part of SWSW.
 - b. Section 6—part of fr. NENE.
 - c. Section 8—part of NENW lying north of county highway "C".

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4. T3N, R8E, village of Monticello, Green county.
 - a. Section 5—part of SESW.
 - b. Section 8—part of NENW, lying south of county highway "C", part of SENW, part of NESW, part of SESW.
 - c. Section 17—part of NWNE.
5. T3N, R8E, town of Mount Pleasant, Green county.
 - a. Section 13—part of SWSW, part of SESW, part of SWSE, part of SESE.
 - b. Section 16—part of NESW, part of NWSW, part of SESW, part of SWSE.
 - c. Section 17—part of SWNE, part of SENE, part of NENW, part of NESE.
 - d. Section 21—part of NENE, part of NWNE.
 - e. Section 22—part of NENE, part of NWNE, part of SWNE, part of SENE, part of NENW, part of NWNW, part of SENW.
 - f. Section 23—part of NENE, part of NWNE, part of NENW, part of NWNW.
 - g. Section 24—part of NWNW.
6. T3N, R9E, town of Albany, Green county.
 - a. Section 16—part of SWSW, part of SESW.
 - b. Section 17—part of NESW, part of NWSW, part of SWSW, part of SESW, part of SWSE, part of SESE.
 - c. Section 18—part of NESW, part of fr. NWSW, part of fr. SWSW, part of SESW, part of NESE, part of NWSE, part of SWSE, part of SESE.
 - d. Section 21—part of NWNE, part of SWNE, part of NENW, part of NWSE, part of SWSE and ending at its intersection with the northwest side of the right of way of state trunk highway 59 in section 21, T3N, R9E, all known as a part of the Sugar River state trail.
