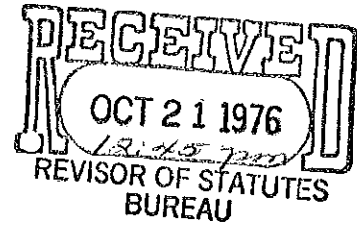

ADOPTING RULES


Pursuant to authority vested in the Department of Industry,  
Labor and Human Relations by sections 101.01 - 101.20, Wis. Stats.,  
the Department hereby adopts the following rule:


IND 90.155 MINIMUM PROJECT COSTS. Effective December 1, 1976,  
section 66.293 (3), Wis. Stats. shall not apply to any public works  
project for which the estimated project cost of completion is  
below \$4,100 where a single trade is involved and \$41,000,  
where more than one trade is involved on such project.


The rule contained herein shall take effect on December 1, 1976,
