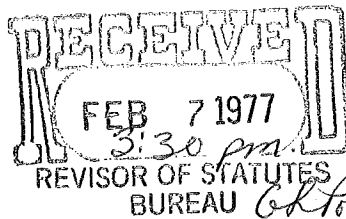

ORDER OF THE STATE OF WISCONSIN DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE
AMENDING RULES

Pursuant to the authority vested in the State of Wisconsin Department of Agriculture by sections 93.07(1) and 97.52, Wis. Stats., the State of Wisconsin Department of Agriculture hereby amends and adopts rules as follow:

1. Section Ag 30.05 of the Wis. Adm. Code is amended to read:

Ag 30.05 Identification of adulterated milk. The department will identify any adulterated or insanitary milk or cream by tagging the container thereof and adding thereto a harmless food color to prevent its being used as human food. The plant operator shall identify adulterated or insanitary milk or cream which it finds by tagging the container thereof.

The rules contained herein shall take effect as provided in section 227.026, Wis. Stats.
