ORDER OF THE STATE OF WISCONSIN NATURAL RESOURCES BOARD

AMENDING RULES

Pursuant to the authority vested in the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board by sections 23.09 and 29.174 and chapter 227, Wisconsin Statutes, the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board hereby amends rules as follows:

SECTION 1 - Section NR 20.04 (7) (a) and (b) are amended to read:

(7) Experimental trophy trout streams. (a) Castle Rock creek -- In, on or along that part of Castle Rock creek, Grant county, from the Church road bridge in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , section 36, T7N, R2W, downstream to the county trunk Q bridge in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , section 31, T7N, R1W.

1. Castle Rock springs -- In, on or along the springhead and spring tributary of Castle Rock creek in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , section 36, T7N, R2W, Grant county.

(b) Doc Smith creek -- In, on or along that part of Doc Smith creek, Grant county, from and including the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , section 1, T6N, R2W, downstream to its mouth (Castle Rock creek).

The foregoing rules were approved and adopted by the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board on November 18, 1976.

The rules contained herein shall take effect upon publication.
