ORDER OF THE STATE OF WISCONSIN NATURAL RESOURCES BOARD

REPEALING, RENUMBERING, AMENDING, REPEALING & RECREATING AND CREATING RULES

Pursuant to the authority vested in the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board by sections 23.09, 23.11, 29.174 and chapter 227, Wisconsin Statutes, the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board hereby repeals, renumbers, amends, repeals and recreates, and creates rules as follows:

SECTION 1 - Section NR 10.001 (2) is created to read:

(2) For the purposes of this chapter, "bait" means honey and any solid or nonliquid material attractive to wildlife.

SECTION 2 - Section NR 10.01 (2) (a) 2. is amended to read:

Kind of animal and locality	Open season (both dates inclusive)	Bag limit
2. Remainder of the state		
except Waukesha county	Beginning on the Saturday nearest October 1 and continuing through December 31	5 each day 10 possession

SECTION 3 - Section NR 10.01 (2) (a) 3. is created to read:

SECTION 6 - Section NR 10.01 (4) (a) 3. is amended to read:

All that part of Buffalo, La Crosse, Beginning on the Saturday Trempealeau and Vernon counties nearest November 1 and lying westerly of state highway 35, continuing through that part of Crawford county begin- November 30 ning with the junction of state highway 35 and the Vernon county line, thence southerly along said highway 35 to its junction with U.S. highway 18, thence westerly along said highway 18 to its junction with the Burlington Northern rail- road, thence southerly along said railroad to its junction with the Grant county line and that part of Grant county lying westerly of the Burlington Northern railroad.</p>	None

SECTION 7 - Section NR 10.01 (4) (a) 4. is created to read:

<p>4. All other parts of the state</p>	<p>Beginning on the Saturday nearest November 8 and continuing through December 31</p>	None

SECTION 8 - Section NR 10.01 (4) (b) is amended to read:

(b) Trapping muskrats. There shall be an additional open season for trapping muskrats for salvage purposes concurrent with the beaver season and with no bag limit in the portions of the state open to beaver trapping as described in section NR 10.01(4)(c).

SECTION 9 - Section NR 10.05 (2) is amended to read:

(2) It shall be unlawful to hunt waterfowl from any railroads including the respective rights-of-way along or within the area described in Wis. Adm. Code section NR 10.01(1)(j).

SECTION 10 - Sections NR 10.05 (3), (4) and (5) are repealed.

SECTION 11 - Section NR 10.06 (2) (a) is amended to read:

(2) (a) General hunting hour zones are established as follows:

Zone

- A - all that part of the state lying east of 88°-00' longitude
- B - all that part of the state lying between 88°-00' and 89°-00' long.
- C - all that part of the state lying between 89°-00' and 90°-00' long.
- D - all that part of the state lying between 90°-00' and 91°-00' long.
- E - all that part of the state lying between 91°-00' and 92°-00' long.
- F - all that part of the state lying west of 92°-00' longitude

SECTION 12 - Section NR 10.07 (1) (b) is renumbered NR 10.07 (1) (c) and amended to read:

- (c) Definitions. 1. Bow shall be defined as any bow, drawn and held by and through the effort of the person releasing it, but does not include crossbow.
2. Crossbow shall be defined as any device using a bow which once drawn is held solely by other means than the effort of the person firing it.

SECTION 13 - Section NR 10.07 (3) is amended to read:

(3) No person shall have in possession or under control any firearm, bow and arrow or crossbow in or on any vehicle or automobile while shining any area inhabited by wild animals.

SECTION 14 - Section NR 10.07 (10) is repealed and recreated to read:

(10) During the period beginning on the Saturday 3 weeks prior to the opening of the bear season established by Wis. Adm. Code section NR 10.01(3)(g)2. and continuing through the end of such season, no person shall place or use bait or hunt any species of wildlife over any bait, including honey, in that portion of the state north of highway 29. *

SECTION 15 - Section NR 10.10 (1) is amended to read:

(1) No person, while hunting or in possession of firearms, bow and arrow or crossbow, shall have in possession or under control any light used for the purpose of shining deer.

SECTION 16 - Section NR 10.10 (6) is repealed.

SECTION 17 - Section NR 10.10 (7) is amended to read:

(7) No person shall place any liquid scent used to attract bear at any time other than during the period beginning on the Saturday 3 weeks prior to the opening of the bear seasons established under Wis. Adm. Code section NR 10.01(3)(g) and continuing through October 15.

SECTION 18 - Section NR 10.10 (8) is amended to read:

(8) No person shall place, use or hunt bear over bait. No liquid scent used for attracting bear shall be placed within 50 yards of any trail, road or campsite used by the public.

SECTION 19 - Section NR 10.14 (7) is created to read:

(7) During the beaver and otter season, it shall be unlawful for any person to set, place or operate any waterset smaller than 5½" jaw spread for steel jaw traps and 8" x 8" for killer traps of the conibear type.

SECTION 20 - Section NR 10.22 (2) (b) and (c) are amended to read:

(b) Permits for hunting migratory game birds, squirrels, and ruffed grouse only shall be issued. Migratory game bird hunting will be permitted only from the opening date of the general duck season through the Sunday immediately prior to the opening day of the deer gun season with bag limits the same as those that apply in the remainder of Wood county. Squirrel and ruffed grouse hunting will be permitted only during the same period open for migratory game bird hunting. The daily bag limit on squirrels and ruffed grouse shall be the same as for the remainder of Wood county.

(c) Daily hunting permits shall be limited to allow not more than 75 hunters for squirrels and ruffed grouse at any one time. Daily hunting permits for migratory game birds shall be limited to 102 or less depending upon seasonal water conditions.

SECTION 21 - Section NR 10.27 (2) is amended to read:

(2) Gun season and December bow and arrow season only: Rock Island state park, Newport state park, Big Bay state park recreation area, Lake Wissota state park recreation area, Tuscobia-Park Falls state trail, Elroy-Sparta state trail, Mirror Lake state park recreation area; Hartman Creek state park, Devil's Lake state park, Interstate state park, Wildcat Mountain state park, Willow River state park and Kinnickinnic state park.

SECTION 22 - Section NR 19.01 is repealed.

SECTION 23 - Section NR 45.09 (1) (z) is created to read:

(z) All waters of the Augusta wildlife area in Eau Claire county.

The foregoing rules were approved and adopted by the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board on November 18, 1976.
