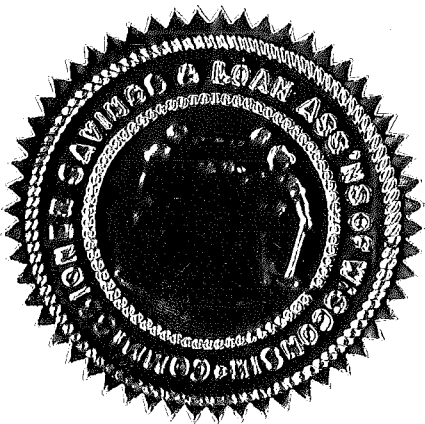

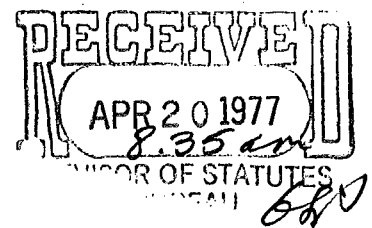

ORDER OF THE  
OFFICE OF THE COMMISSIONER OF SAVINGS AND LOAN  
ADOPTING RULES

Order No. 99

WHEREAS, on February 9, 1977, a final draft of the following rule was approved by the Commissioner and the Savings and Loan Review Board; and

WHEREAS, official notice of the proposed rule change was published in the Wisconsin Administrative Register for February 1977 in accordance with s. 227.02(1)(e), Wis. Stats., and no petition for a public hearing on the proposed change has been filed with this office during the more than 30 days that have succeeded such publication; and

WHEREAS, on February 17, 1977, members of the appropriate standing committees of the legislature were duly notified of the proposed rule change in accordance with section 227.018(2) of the Wisconsin Statutes, and within the more than 30 days that have succeeded such notice no committee of the legislature has directed this office to meet with it to review the draft; now, therefore

Pursuant to authority vested in the Office of the Commissioner of Savings and Loan by sections 215.02(7), 215.26(5), and 227.014(2) of the statutes, the Commissioner of Savings and Loans hereby adopts rules as follows:

Chapter S-L 7 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is repealed and recreated to read:

COMMISSIONER'S DESIGNATION OF  
LEGAL HOLIDAYS

S-L 7.01 DAYS ON WHICH ASSOCIATIONS MUST BE CLOSED. (1) No association may be open for business on any of the following days:


- (a) January 1.
- (b) 3rd Monday in February.
- (c) Last Monday in May.
- (d) July 4.
- (e) 1st Monday in September.
- (f) 2nd Monday in October.
- (g) November 11.
- (h) 4th Thursday in November.
- (i) December 25.
- (j) Good Friday from noon to 3 p.m.

(2) If any of the days designated in subsection (1) fall on a Sunday, the association may not be open for business on the succeeding Monday.

(3) Operation of a remote service unit as defined in s. 215.13 (46) (a) 1 of the statutes or an unstaffed facility is not deemed to constitute the transaction of business.

S-L 7.02 ADDITIONAL OBSERVANCE DAYS PERMITTED. An association's board of directors may designate additional days on which the association will not be open for business.

The rule change contained in this order shall take effect on the first day of the month following its publication in the Wisconsin Administrative Register.
