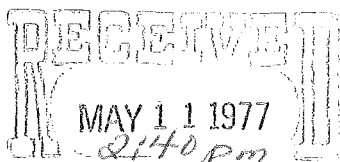

ORDER OF THE STATE OF WISCONSIN NATURAL RESOURCES BOARD  
AMENDING AND REPEALING & RECREATING RULES

Pursuant to the authority vested in the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board by sections 147.025, 147.04(2)(a) & (3)(a), and 227.014(2)(b), Wisconsin Statutes, the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board hereby amends, and repeals and recreates rules as follows:

SECTION 1 - Section NR 200.04 (1) intro. par. is amended to read:

NR 200.04 General filing requirements. (1) Unless otherwise provided in this chapter all existing discharges for which an application is required under sections NR 200.03(1)(a) and (b) shall have a complete application on file on or before January 17, 1974, unless an application adequately describing the present discharge has been filed with:

SECTION 2 - Section NR 200.04 (6) is amended to read:

(6) Applications shall be filed with the Department of Natural Resources, WPDES Permit Section, Box 7921, Madison, Wisconsin 53707.

SECTION 3 - Section NR 200.04 (7) is amended to read:

(7) Applications shall be filed on one or more of the forms prescribed in the chapter. In most cases only one form will be required.

SECTION 4 - Section NR 200.07 (1) (b) is amended to read:

(b) If such new or increased discharge will not result in exceeding or violating any effluent limitations of the permit, such notice shall be given in the form of a letter addressed to the Department of Natural Resources, WPDES Permit Section, Box 7921, Madison, Wisconsin 53707. Said letter shall refer to the number and expiration date of the existing permit, describe the proposed expansion, production increase, or process modification, and include a statement that no effluent limitation of the permit will be exceeded or violated. Such letter of notification shall be signed by the person required to sign applications and monitoring reports.

SECTION 5 - Section NR 200.10 (2) is amended to read:

(2) Forms may be obtained from the district offices of the department or the Department of Natural Resources, WPDES Permit Section, Box 7921, Madison, Wisconsin 53707.

SECTION 6 - Section NR 200.11 is repealed and recreated to read:

NR 200.11 Short form A. Sewerage systems and treatment works. (1) This form shall be used by owners or operators of:

(a) Publicly owned sewerage systems and treatment works; and

(b) Privately owned treatment works receiving domestic sewage only, exclusive of such works receiving also wastes from industrial, agricultural, or service establishment point sources for which applications are required on short form C or D.

(2) The application shall be on forms supplied by the department.

(3) Owners or operators of publicly owned treatment works will be required to submit applications on standard form A if any of the conditions listed in section NR 200.15 are met.

SECTION 7 - Section NR 200.13 is repealed and recreated to read:

NR 200.13 Short form C. Industrial, manufacturing, and mining. (1) This form shall be used by owners or operators of:

(a) Industrial, manufacturing and mining point sources including steam electric power plants, producers of sand, gravel, and stone, and the dairy, meat packing, and fruit and vegetable freezing and canning industries; and

(b) Silvicultural point sources as defined in subsection (4) of this section.

(2) The application shall be on forms supplied by the department.

(3) Owners or operators using short form C will be required to submit applications on standard form C if any of the conditions listed in section NR 200.16 are met.

(4) For the purposes of this section: (a) "Silvicultural point source" means any discernible confined and discrete conveyance related to rock crushing and gravel washing facilities or log sorting or storage facilities which are operated in connection with silvicultural activities and from which pollutants are discharged into surface waters of the state;

(b) "Rock crushing and gravel washing facilities" means those facilities which process crushed and broken stone, gravel, and riprap; and

(c) "Log sorting or storage facilities" means those facilities wherein discharges result from the holding of unprocessed wood (logs or round wood with, or after removal of, bark) in mill or log ponds or on land storage areas where water is intentionally applied to the logs.

(5) Applications for silvicultural point sources shall be filed by December 31, 1976.

NOTE: Discharges from facilities described in (4)(b) and (c) are subject to effluent limitations set forth in Wis. Adm. Code chapters NR 269 and NR 297 respectively.

SECTION 8 - Section NR 200.14 is repealed and recreated to read:

NR 200.14 Short form D. Wholesale, retail, service, and other commercial establishments. (1) This form shall be used by owners or operators of wholesale and retail trade outlets and service or other commercial establishments not engaged in manufacturing or agriculture. Applicants using this form may be required to file an application on standard form C if any of the conditions listed in section NR 200.16 are met.

(2) The application shall be on forms supplied by the department.

The foregoing rules were approved and adopted by the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board on December 16, 1976.

The rules contained herein shall take effect upon publication.
