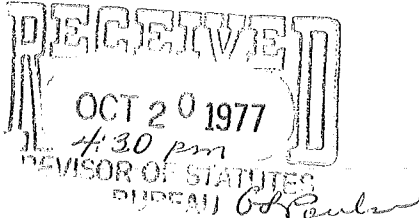

An order to renumber section Eth 1.02(7) and to create section Eth 1.02(7) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code.

Pursuant to the authority vested in the State of Wisconsin Ethics Board by section 19.48(1) and Chapter 227, Wisconsin Statutes, the Ethics Board modifies its rules as follows:

This rule identifies clerical employes of the Legislative Council and Legislative Fiscal Bureau as the nonprofessional legislative employes exempted from the Code of Ethics for Public Officials by section 105, Chapter 29, Laws of 1977 which provided:

SECTION 105. 19.42(8) of the statutes is amended to read:

19.42(8) "State public official" means all persons appointed by the governor with the advice and consent of the senate, ~~except trustees of any private higher educational institution receiving state appropriations,~~ and all persons identified under s. 20.923, except officers and employes of the judiciary, trustees and employes of the investment board and teaching personnel of the university of Wisconsin system, nonprofessional legislative employes, and trustees of any private higher educational institution receiving state appropriations.


