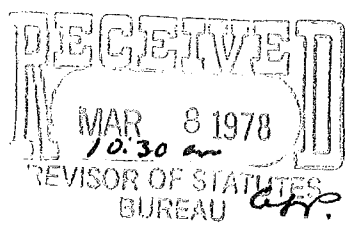



ORDER OF
THE DEPARTMENT OF INDUSTRY, LABOR AND HUMAN RELATIONS
ADOPTING, AMENDING, OR REPEALING RULES

Pursuant to authority vested in the Department of Industry, Labor and Human Relations by sections 101.01 - 101.20, Wisconsin Statutes, the Department of Industry, Labor and Human Relations hereby creates, repeals, amends, and adopts rules as follows:

Chapter IND 76 of the WISCONSIN ADMINISTRATIVE CODE is repealed.

The rules, amendments, and repeals contained herein shall take effect on the first day of the month following publication in the Wisconsin Administrative Register, as provided in section 227.026, Wis. Stats.
