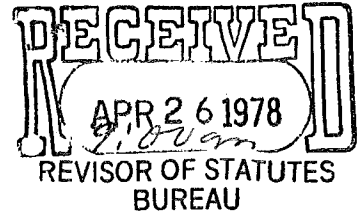

Pursuant to the authority vested in the Department of Transportation by sections 110.06(1), 227.014 and 343.305, Wis. Stats., the Secretary hereby amends the order of adoption of rules repealing and recreating Chapter MVD 25, Wis. Admin. Code, relating to the breath alcohol and testing, approval program, dated April 19, 1978 and filed with the Secretary of State on April 20, 1978, in the following respects:

MVD 25.12(8) as amended and corrected should read:

"MVD 25.12(8) Any person whose permit has been revoked, suspended or cancelled as provided in this chapter shall have the right to appeal to the transportation commission."

MVD 25.03(2)(h) as amended and corrected should read:

"MVD 25.03(2)(h) When a person with an actual blood alcohol concentration between 0.06% and 0.09% by weight is tested, the device shall not give a fail reading if that device is equipped with a bar light configuration."

The amended words above are underscored and were inadvertently omitted from the rule text previously filed in these proceedings.
