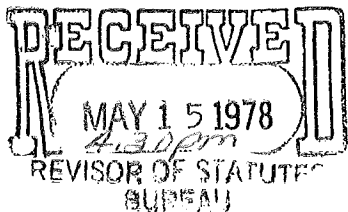

ORDER OF THE PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION  
ADOPTING RULES

Pursuant to authority vested in the Public Service Commission by §§196.85, 196.02, 227.014 and 227.02(b), Stats., the Public Service Commission hereby amends rules as follows:

Wis. Adm. Code §PSC 5.10(2)(a) is amended to read:


PSC 5.10 Direct charges; procedure for billing and collection of expenses.

(2) BILLING (a) The statute provides that the Commission shall ascertain the expenses reasonably attributable to the specific investigation "and shall ~~render~~ send a bill therefor, by registered mail to the public utility, power district, or sewerage district or railroad, either at the conclusion of the investigation, appraisal or services, or ~~from time to time~~ during its progress, which bill shall constitute notice of said the assessment and demand of payment thereof."
