## ORDER ADOPTING RULES

Pursuant to authority vested in the Medical Examining Board by Sections 15.08(5), 227.08 and 448.40, Wis. Stats., the board hereby amends and adopts rules as follows:

Sections Med. 3.02 (1) and (3) of the WISCONSIN ADMINISTRATIVE CODE are amended to read:

- (1) A completed and verified application form for this purpose as required in Section Med 1.02(1), Wis. Adm. Code.
- (3) A curriculum vitae setting out the applicant's education and qualifications and a verified photographic copy of the diploma (with translation) conferring the degree of doctor of medicine granted to the applicant by such school.

Sections Med 3.02(6) (7) and (8) of the WISCONSIN ADMINISTRATIVE CODE are created to read:

- (6) Documentary evidence of noteworthy attainment in a specialized field of medicine.
- (7) Documentary evidence of post-graduate training completed in the United States and/or foreign countries.
- (8) Oral interview conducted by the Board.

The amendments contained herein shall take effect as provided in Section 227.026, Wis. Stats.
