


ORDER AMENDING RULES

:

Pursuant to authority vested in the Cosmetology Examining Board by sections 15.08, 159.03, 227.014 and 227.02, Wis. Stats., and in accordance with the provisions of ss. 1240 and 1499, Chapter 29, Laws of 1977, the Cosmetology Examining Board hereby amends rules respectively as follows:

- I. Section C 2.14(1) of the WISCONSIN ADMINISTRATIVE CODE is amended to read:
 - (1) At least $20 \ \underline{14}$ hours of the $50 \ \underline{34}$ hours of continuing education required by section 159.08(9), Wis. Stats., must be related to academic classes.
- II. Section 3.01(2)(e) of the WISCONSIN ADMINISTRATIVE CODE is amended to read:
 - (e) \$5.00-permit-fee. The fee specified in s.440.05(6), Wis. Stats.
