

ORDER OF THE DEPARTMENT OF REGULATION & LICENSING ADOPTING RULES

Pursuant to the authority vested in the Department of Regulation and Licensing by Section 440.03, Wis. Stats., the Department of Regulation and Licensing hereby adopts rules as follows:

I. Section RL 2.04 of the WISCONSIN ADMINISTRATIVE CODE is created to read:

RL 2.04 Commencement of Disciplinary Proceedings. Disciplinary proceedings are commenced when a notice of hearing is filed in the board office or with a designated hearing examiner.

II. Section RL 2.09(4) of the WISCONSIN ADMINISTRATIVE CODE is amended to read:

(4) An answer to a complaint must be filed within twenty days after the complaint has been served on the respondent.

III. Section RL 2.07(2) (Introductory Clause) is amended to read:

(2) A notice of hearing to the respondent shall be substantially in the following form and signed by a board member or attorney in the division:

The rules or amendments to rules contained herein shall take effect on March 1, 1979.
