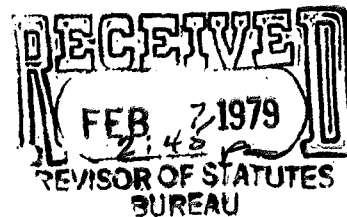

ORDER ADOPTING RULES

Pursuant to authority vested in the Medical Examining Board by sections 15.08(5), 227.08 and 448.40, Wis.Stats., the board hereby amends and adopts rules as follows:


Sections Med 13.01, 13.02<sup>(1)</sup> and 13.04 of the WISCONSIN ADMINISTRATIVE CODE are amended to read:

Med 13.01 Authority and purpose. The rules in this chapter are adopted by the medical examining board pursuant to the authority delegated by section 15.08(5), 227.08 and 448.40, Wis.Stats., and govern the biennial training requirements for physicians as provided under section 448.13, Wis. Stats.

Med 13.02 Continuing medical education required: waiver. (1) Each physician required to complete the biennial training requirement provided under section 448.13, Wis. Stats., shall, in each second year at the time of making application for a certificate of registration as required under section 448.07, Wis. Stats., have submitted to the board proof of attendance at and completion of at least 30 hours of acceptable continuing medical educational programs within the two calendar years immediately preceding the calendar year for which application for registration is made.

Med 13.04 Post graduate training program; length of service. The board will accept postgraduate training in a program approved by the board under the provisions of section Med 1.02(3), Wis.Adm.Code, as fulfilling the requirements of this chapter for continuing medical education. Three consecutive months of such postgraduate training shall be deemed to equal 30 hours of acceptable continuing medical education for the purposes of this chapter.

The amendments contained herein shall take effect as provided in Section 227.026, Wis. Stats.
