## ORDER ADOPTING RULES

Pursuant to authority vested in the Medical Examining Board by sections 15.08(5), 227.08 and 448.40, Wis. Stats., the board hereby repeals, amends and adopts rules as follows:

Section Med 14.05 of the WISCONSIN ADMINISTRATIVE CODE is repealed.

Sections Med 14.01, 14.03, 14.04, 14.06 and 14.07 of the WISCONSIN ADMINISTRATIVE CODE is amended to read:

Med 14.01 Authority and purpose. The rules in this chapter are adopted by the medical examining board pursuant to the authority delegated by sections 15.08(5), 227.08 and 448.40, Wis. Stats., and govern biennial registration of licensees of the board.

Med 14.03 Registration required; method of registration. Each licensee shall register biennially with the board. On or before December 1 of each odd-numbered year the board will mail to each licensee at his last known address as it appears in the records of the board an application form for registration. Each licensee shall complete such application form and return it together with the required fee to the office of the board prior to the next succeeding January 1.

Med 14.04 Initial registration. Any licensee who is initially granted and issued a license during a given calendar year shall automatically be registered for that biennium.

Med 14.06 is renumbered to 14.05.

Med 14.05 Registration prohibited, annulled; re-registration. Any physician required to comply with the provisions of section 448.43, Wis. Stats., and of chapter Med 13, Wis.Adm.Code, and who has not so complied, will not be permitted to register. Any person whose license has been suspended or revoked will not be permitted to register, and the registration of any such person shall be deemed automatically annulled upon receipt by the secretary of the board of a verified report of such suspension or revocation, subject to such person's right of appeal. A person whose license has been suspended or revoked and subsequently restored shall be re-registered by the board upon receipt by the board of both a verified report of such restoration and a completed registration form.

Med 14.07 is renumbered to 14.06.

The amendments contained herein shall take effect as provided in Section 227.026, Wis. Stats.
