ORDER OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES REPEALING, RECREATING AND AMENDING RULES

Pursuant to authority vested in the Department of Health and Social Services by section 227.014(2), Wis. Stats., and section 140.05(17), Wis. Stats., the Department of Health and Social Services hereby repeals, recreates and amends rules as follows:

Chapter PW-MH 60.70(2)(c) of the WISCONSIN ADMINISTRATIVE CODE is amended to read:

PW-MH 60.70(2)(c) Activity Therapy. Each program, excluding outpatient, shall provide at lease one full-time activity therapist. In addition to having formal training in children and adolescents' growth and development, preference shall be given to those professionals who have had clinical training or professional experience with emotionally disturbed children and adolescents.

The rules contained herein shall take effect on the first day of the month following publication in the WISCONSIN ADMINISTRATIVE REGISTER as provided in section 227.026, Wis. Stats.
