

Analysis by the Department of Transportation

A number of chapters of the Department of Transportation's rules relating to traffic signs and traffic control devices are obsolete in that they have been replaced by the "Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices" adopted by the Department in accordance with sec. 84.02(4)(e), Stats. Also, the underlying rule-making authority for these rules was eliminated by the enactment of Chapter 116, Laws of 1977. The "Uniform Manual" is available for reference in all Department District Transportation offices and has been distributed to all county, municipal and local highway maintenance authorities and most professional highway engineers and road builders. The repeal of these rules will reduce the bulk of the Administrative Code and eliminate confusion about what standards apply to the design, location and installation of traffic signs and traffic control devices.

These rule changes will have no local fiscal effect.

Pursuant to authority vested in the Wisconsin Department of Transportation by secs. 110.06, 227.014 and 227.02(1)(b), Wis. Stats., the Department of Transportation hereby repeals rules interpreting and implementing various and sundry statutes relating to the design, location and installation of traffic signs and traffic control devices, as follows:

Chapters Hy 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 20, 21 and 22 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code are repealed. The repeal of rules contained in this office shall take effect upon publication as provided in sec. 227.02(1)(intro.), Wis. Stats.
