

Analysis by the Department of Transportation

Chapter MVD 1, Wis. Admin. Code, relating to pleading, practice and procedure before the Division of Motor Vehicles is obsolete. The 1977 Budget Act (Chapter 29, Laws of 1977) eliminated the statutory status of the Division, which now exists as an administratively created unit within the Department of Transportation. Also, the law provided that commencing on January 1, 1978, all administrative contested cases involving the Department of Transportation are to be heard and decided by the Wisconsin Transportation Commission which is governed by its own rules of practice and procedure.


This rule change has no local fiscal effect.

Pursuant to authority vested in the Wisconsin Department of Transportation by secs. 110.06 and 227.014, Wis. Stats., the Department of Transportation hereby repeals rules interpreting chs. 218, 227, 340 to 349, Wis. Stats., and other related statutes pertaining to procedure and practice in contested cases, as follows:

Chapter MVD 1 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is repealed.
