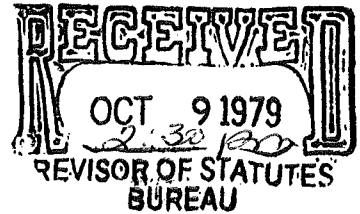

I also certify that this rule amendment has received prior approval as required under sec. 110.06(2), Wis. Stats.

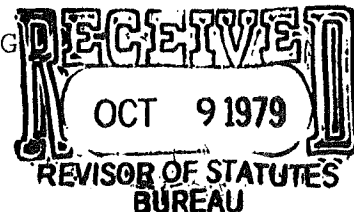

Analysis Prepared by the Department of Transportation

This rule presently provides that "...no oral test will be given to persons applying for a school bus license." The amendment changes this to require that there be a written examination for a person's first school bus operator license, thereby allowing the option of written or oral examinations for renewals.

Authority for the existing rule and this amendment is provided by sec. 110.06(2), Stats., which requires the adoption of rules necessary in the interests of safety to cover the operation of school buses, and by sec. 343.12(2)(h), Stats., which requires the Department of Transportation to prescribe and administer the examination for school bus operator licenses.

Fiscal estimate. The Department of Transportation intends to implement this rule amendment within the existing budget for the school bus operator testing program. For this reason, the amendment is estimated to have no state fiscal effect. There is no local fiscal effect.

Forms. This rule amendment will require a new form for the administration of oral school bus operator examinations and may require the revision of other school bus operator licensing forms. A copy of any such new or revised form can be obtained at no charge by writing to the Division of Motor Vehicles, Bureau of Driver Control, P. O. Box 7917, Madison, Wisconsin 53707.

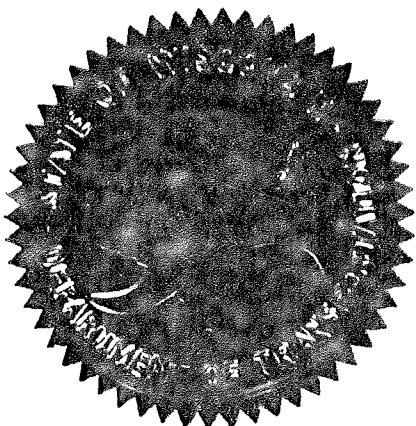
Pursuant to authority vested in the Wisconsin Department of Transportation by secs. 110.06, 227.014, and 343.12(2)(h), Wis. Stats., the Department of Transportation hereby amends MVD 14.09(1), Wis. Admin. Code, as follows:

Section MVD 14.09(1), Wis. Admin. Code, is amended to read:

"MVD 14.09 TEST ON KNOWLEDGE OF TRAFFIC LAWS AND EVALUA-
TION OF HEARING. (1) The test on knowledge of traffic laws
shall consist of a series of questions concerning traffic
laws and rules of the road, vehicle equipment and safe driving
practices. This test may be administered as a written examina-
tion or as an oral examination, as determined by the division,
except no oral test will be given to ~~persons~~ a person applying
for a his or her first school bus operator license."
