Ind 90.155 Minimum Project Costs. Effective February 1, 1980, subsection 66.293 (3) Wisconsin Statutes, shall not apply to any public works project for which the estimated project cost of completion is below \$6,000 where a single trade is involved, and \$60,000 where more than one trade is involved in such project.
