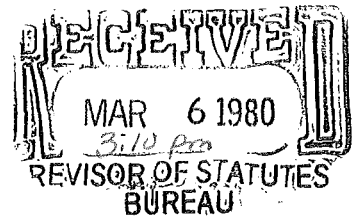

ORDER OF THE COMMISSIONER OF INSURANCE

Repealing a Rule

Relating to a rule repealing the Insurance Consumers
Advisory Council.

ANALYSIS PREPARED BY THE OFFICE OF THE COMMISSIONER OF INSURANCE

Wisconsin Administrative Code section Ins 6.79 authorizes creation of advisory councils for life and disability insurance, for property and casualty insurance and for insurance financial matters. Each council will consist of nine members, and the Commissioner of Insurance, of which three members will be public (consumer) representatives. The public members on the separate advisory councils will better represent the interests of consumers in insurance matters than a separate consumer's advisory council so that Wisconsin Administrative Code section Ins 6.53, Insurance Consumers Advisory Council, can be repealed. The council has been inactive for several months.

Pursuant to authority vested in the Commissioner of Insurance by section 601.41 (3), Wisconsin Statutes, the Commissioner of Insurance hereby repeals a rule interpreting sections 227.017 and 601.20, Wis. Stats., as follows:

Section Ins 6.53 Insurance Consumers Advisory Council is repealed.

The repeal contained in this Order shall take effect as provided in section 227.026 (1), Wis. Stats.
