

In the Matter of the Proposed Creation of MVD 11.05(4) to (7) of the Wis. Adm. Code Relating to Length of Discretionary License Revocations or Suspensions.

Order Adopting Rule

Pursuant to authority vested in the Department of Transportation by ss. 110.06, 227.014 and 343.32(3), Stats., the Secretary of Transportation hereby adopts rules interpreting s. 343.32, Stats. as follows:

MVD 11.05(4) to (7) of the Wis. Adm. Code are created to read:

(4) The following demerit point accumulations, calculated from the date of violation, shall result in the following revocation or suspension periods.

Demerit Points Accumulated

in a 12 Month Period

12 to 16 points

17 to 22 points

23 to 30 points

More than 30 points

- (5) The effective date of all departmental suspensions or revocations under this rule shall be the date the order was mailed, except, if the person is currently under suspension or revocation, the effective date shall be the date the license was surrendered for the previous action, or the date of the conviction causing the new suspension or revocation, whichever is later.
- (6) Revocations under the provisions of s. 343.32 (1) (b), Stats., shall be for a period of six months. If a person was convicted of a traffic violation that was a cause of an accident that resulted in the death of another, there shall be a revocation for a period of 6 months under the provisions of s. 343.32 (1) (a), Stats.
- (7) Any court ordered revocation or suspension for the same violation shall supersede a revocation or suspension under this section, except that the minimum length of any revocation or suspension shall be 2 months.
