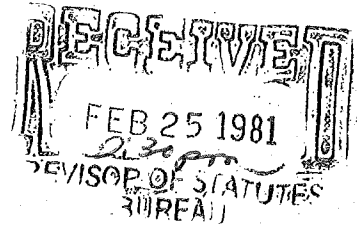



IN THE MATTER OF RULEMAKING : ORDER OF THE ARCHITECTS,
PROCEEDINGS BEFORE THE ARCHITECTS, : PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERS, DESIGNERS,
PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERS, DESIGNERS : AND LAND SURVEYORS EXAMINING BOARD
AND LAND SURVEYORS EXAMINING BOARD : REPEALING, AMENDING OR ADOPTING RULES

ORDER

Now, therefore, it is ordered that pursuant to authority vested in the Architects, Professional Engineers, Designers and Land Surveyors Examining Board in sections 15.08(5), 227.014, and Chapter 443, Stats., the Architects, Professional Engineers, Designers and Land Surveyors Examining Board hereby amends and adopts emergency rules interpreting s. 443.03(1), Stats., as follows:

Section A-E 1.15⁽⁴⁾(c) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is amended to read:

(c) Scope of examination. Examinations administered to applicants seek to determine the applicant's preparedness to exercise skills likely to be needed by an architect practicing architecture at the time of the examination. Each examination, prior to being offered by the examining board, is reviewed by the architects' section to determine that the examination is reasonably related to the skills likely to be needed by a practicing architect and that the examination tests the applicant's preparedness to exercise such skills.

The examination will include material relating to the practice of architecture in the State of Wisconsin, with emphasis placed on Wisconsin law, including the registration law for architects, the board's rules, natural energy design, including both active and passive natural energy design, the design needs of people with physical disabilities and relevant statutes, codes and procedures of the department of industry, labor and human relations and other state agencies relating to the practice of architecture.

The rule contained in this order shall take effect upon the first day of the month following publication in the Wisconsin administrative register.
