> ORDER OF ADMINISTRATOR, DIVISION OF PERSONNEL ADOPTING EMERGENCY RULES

Relating to residency requirements for classified state employes.

Analysis prepared by the Division of Personnel

Under current statutes, Wisconsin residency, as defined under s. 230.03(12), Stats. is required for persons who participate in competitive examinations. Recruitment for such examinations is limited to persons in the state, except where the Administrator determines there is a critical shortage of persons possessing the skills or qualifications.

The Division of Personnel interprets these requirements to apply to all applicants for state classified employment.

This proposed rule formally identifies the residency requirements for permanent appointments and clarifies the requirements for residency as they apply to Limited Term Appointments under 230.26(1), Stats. and Project Appointments under 230.27(2), Stats.

Order and Text of Emergency Rules

Pursuant to the authority vested in the Administrator, Division of Personnel by sections 230.05(1), 230.05(5), 230.26(1) and 230.27(2), Stats., the Administrator, Division of Personnel hereby adopts these emergency rules to interpret and administer sections 230.03(12), 230.14(2), 230.16(2), 230.26(1) and 230.27(2), Stats. as follows:

SECTION 1. Pers 6.015 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is created to read:

Pers 6.015 RESIDENCY. The administrator may authorize agency recruitment, selection and appointment of persons who are not Wisconsin residents only if the administrator has determined that there is a critical shortage of Wisconsin residents possessing the skills and qualifications required for the position. Such authorization is subject to prior approval by the administrator.

SECTION 2. Pers 10.04(3) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is created to read:

Pers 10.04(3) Residency requirements for limited term appointments shall be consistent with the Wisconsin residency requirements established for appointment to permanent positions under s. Pers 6.015, Wis. Adm. Code.
