NR 207.01 Purpose. The purpose of this chapter is to provide for the incorporation of effluent limitations into discharge permits required under s. 147.02, Stats., as soon as possible after the promulgation of federal regulations establishing BCT or BAT effluent guidelines.

NR 207.02 Applicability. This chapter is applicable to discharge permits issued during the period of June 1, 1981 through December 31, 1982 for all categories and classes of point sources listed in s. NR 220.02, Wis. Adm. Code.

NR 207.03 Definitions. Terms used in this chapter are defined in s. NR 205.03, Wis. Adm. Code. Abbreviations used in this chapter are defined in s. NR 205.04, Wis. Adm. Code.

NR 207.04 Establishment of limitations based upon federal regulations. In the event that federal regulations establishing BCT or BAT effluent guidelines have been promulgated for a point source included in one of the categories and classes of point sources listed in s. NR 220.02, Wis. Adm. Code, the department may establish in the discharge permit for such source, effluent limitations based upon these federal regulations, provided that:

- (1) The federal regulations are promulgated during the period September 1, 1980 through December 31, 1982; and
- (2) The discharge permit is issued or reissued during the period June 1, 1981 through December 31, 1982.

NR 207.05 Establishment of effluent guideline limitations in the Wisconsin administrative code. The department shall, as soon as possible after the promulgation of any federal regulations establishing BCT or BAT effluent guidelines for certain categories and classes of point sources, adopt appropriate effluent guideline limitations for such point sources in the Wisconsin administrative code.

NR 207.06 Provision for modification. Any WPDES permits containing effluent limitations established under s. NR 207.04 shall be mod-

ified under s. 147.03, Stats., to reflect applicable BCT or BAT effluent limitations later promulgated in the Wisconsin administrative code.

NR 207.07 Severability. If any section, paragraph, phrase, sentence or clause of this chapter is declared invalid or unconstitutional for any reason, the remainder of this chapter shall not be affected thereby.

(3) OTHER VARIANCES. (a) The Flambeau river from the upper dam at Park Falls downstream to the Crowley dam shall meet the standards for fish and aquatic life and recreational use except that the dissolved oxygen shall not be lowered to less than 3.0 mg/l at any time.

(b) Newton creek from Stinson avenue to the mouth at Superior Bay in the city of Superior, Douglas county is classified as a noncontinuous stream. The water quality of Newton creek shall meet those criteria specified in s. NR 102.02 (1), Wis. Adm. Code, and shall be maintained at a dissolved oxygen concentration of at least 5.0 mg/l at all times. Superior Bay shall meet the standards for fish and aquatic life and recreational uses except that the average total ammonia nitrogen concentration in the bay shoreward from Hog Island shall not exceed 2.83 mg/l. Determinations of average total ammonia nitrogen concentration shall be based on samples taken at 4 representative locations.
