



#### REPEALING RULES

IN THE MATTER of repealing section NR 104.07(2) Table 5, entry 46 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code pertaining to water quality standards classification for an unnamed tributary to the Manitowoc River near St. Nazianz



#### Analysis Prepared by Department of Natural Resources

The repeal of section NR 104.07(2), Table 5, entry 46 will modify the existing water quality standards classification for the unnamed tributary to the Manitowoc River near St. Nazianz. The current classification allows a variance for portions of the unnamed tributary. In 1980 the unnamed tributary receiving the effluent from the St. Nazianz wastewater treatment facility was reevaluated to determine if that creek was capable of supporting fish and aquatic life organisms. It was determined that the creek was capable of supporting foraging minnows and possibly some non-game fish.

The Village of St. Nazianz has requested the change in classification from intermediate aquatic life to full fish and aquatic life. This rule change will allow the Department to modify the conditions of the WPDES permit for the Village of St. Nazianz wastewater treatment facility.

Pursuant to the authority vested in the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board by sections 144.025(2)(b), 227.014 and 227.02(1)(e), Wisconsin Statutes, the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board hereby repeals rules interpreting section 144.025(2)(b), Wisconsin Statutes, as follows:

SECTION 1 - Section NR 104.07 (2), Table 5, entry 46 is repealed.

The foregoing rules were approved and adopted by the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board on December 17, 1980.

The rules contained herein shall take effect upon publication as provided in section 227.026(1) intro., Wisconsin Statutes.
