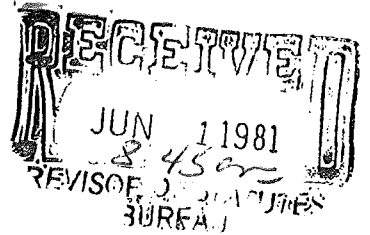

ORDER OF THE
TAX APPEALS COMMISSION
ADOPTING AND REPEALING RULES

Relating to rules concerning practice and procedures before the Tax Appeals Commission.

Analysis by the Tax Appeals Commission

This rule repeals and recreates the chapter of rules establishing practices and procedures in presenting a case to the Tax Appeals Commission. The rule updates terminology, deletes obsolete provisions and language, organizes the chapter into subchapters for clarity, and codifies many of the commission's long-standing procedures.


Pursuant to the authority vested in the Tax Appeals Commission by ss.70.995(8)(c), 71.12(1)(c), 73.01(4)(b) and 227.014(2), Wis. Stats., the Tax Appeals Commission hereby repeals and recreates the rules interpreting various statutes identified after each rule section's title in the attached draft as follows:

Wis. Adm. Code chapter TA 1 is repealed and recreated to read as set out in the attached draft.

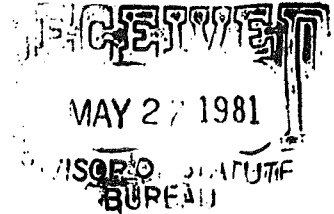

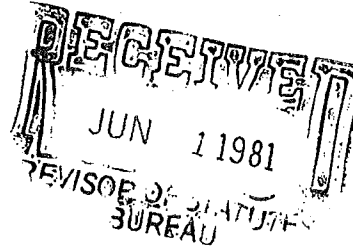
