## ORDER

Now, therefore, it is ordered that, pursuant to authority vested in the Veterinary Examining Board in s. 15.08(5)(b) and Chapter 453, Stats., the Veterinary Examining Board hereby creates and adopts rules, interpreting ss. 15.08(5)(b) and 453.07, Stats., as follows:

Section 1. Section VE 3.02(21) of the Wisconsin administrative code is created to read:

(21) Failure to keep records as a dispenser of controlled substances as required by s. 161.31, Stats., and s. Phar 6.02, Wis. Adm. Code.

Section 2. Section VE 3.02(22) of the Wisconsin administrative code is created to read:

(22) Failure to keep animal patient records which specify adequately the diagnosis made and treatment provided an animal.

The rules contained in this order shall take effect on the first day of the month following publication in the Wisconsin administrative register, pursuant to s. 227.026, Stats.
