

## ORDER OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES REPEALING RULES

Relating to rules concerning sanitary care of schools.

Analysis prepared by the Department of Health and Social Services:

Chapter H 70, Wis. Adm. Code, was promulgated in 1956 or earlier under the former State Board of Health's general authority and duty to protect public health under s. 140.05, Stats. The Department of Health and Social Services, successor agency to the Board of Health, no longer enforces H 70 because schools are adequately regulated by rules of the Department of Industry, Labor, and Human Relations (DILHR), including H 62.13 and Ind 56. Because H 70 is inoperative and duplicative of rules of DILHR, the repeal of this chapter will have no fiscal effect.

Pursuant to authority vested in the Department of Health and Social Services by s. 140.05(3), Stats., the Department of Health and Social Services hereby repeals rules interpreting s. 140.05(1), Stats., as follows:

Chapter H 70 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is repealed.

Rules repealed by this order are repealed effective the first day of the month following publication of notice of repeal in the Wisconsin Administrative Register, as provided in s. 227.026(1), Stats.
