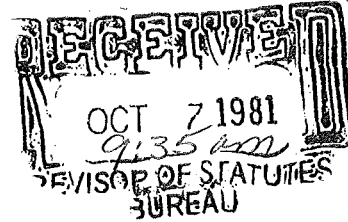




TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, GREETINGS:

ORDER OF THE EMPLOYE TRUST FUNDS BOARD

REPEALING RULES

Relating to rules concerning eligibility of part-time teaching assistants,  
teachers' affidavits, and receipt of annuity while teaching.

---

Analysis Prepared by the Department of Employee Trust Funds

This order is a housekeeping type of action to repeal rules that are redundant or no longer needed due to statutory amendments. Eligibility of part-time teaching assistants for participation in the retirement fund is determined under the provisions of sections 42.40 (4) and (7), Stats., therefore TR 3.03, Wis. Adm. Code, is no longer necessary. The requirement for a teacher's affidavit as provided in TR 5.01 was repealed in Chapter 20, Laws of 1973. The condition on which an annuity would have benefits cease is specifically set forth in s. 42.245 (5), therefore, TR 8.02 is redundant and not needed.

Pursuant to authority vested in the Employee Trust Funds Board by s. 42.22 (2), Wis. Stats., and Chapter 280, Laws of 1975, the Employee Trust Funds Board hereby repeals rules interpreting sections 42.40 (4), 42.40 (7), and 42.245 (5), Wis. Stats., as follows:

Section TR 3.03 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is repealed.

Section TR 5.01 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is repealed.

Section TR 8.02 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is repealed.

The repeals contained in this order shall take effect as provided in section 227.026 (1) (intro.), Stats.

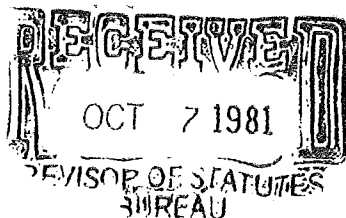
