ORDER OF THE EMPLOYE TRUST FUNDS BOARD

REPEALING RULES

Relating to the requirement that the Wisconsin Retirement Find Board approve the cancellation of notices of termination of employment NOV 9 1981

Analysis Prepared by the Department of Employe Trust Funds

This order removes the provision that required the Wisconsin Retirement Fund Board to formally approve the cancellation of notices of termination of employment. These notices are, at times, submitted to the department in error, or the wrong notice is submitted when a person applies for a disability annuity. In these cases, the Wisconsin Retirement Fund Board has been required by Ret 2.31 to approve the withdrawal of the forms by the employers. The Employe Trust Funds Board had decided that this is an insignificant administrative procedure that really does not require Board action, and therefore has acted to repeal this rule which interprets in part s. 41.04 (2) (e), Stats.

Pursuant to authority vested in the Employe Trust Funds Board by s. 41.04 (2) (e),

Stats., and Chapter 280, Laws of 1975, the Employe Trust Funds Board hereby
repeals a rule interpreting s. 41.04 (2) (e), Stats., as follows:

Section 1. Ret 2.31 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is repealed.

The repeal contained in this order shall take effect as provided in s. 227.026 (1) (intro.), Stats.
