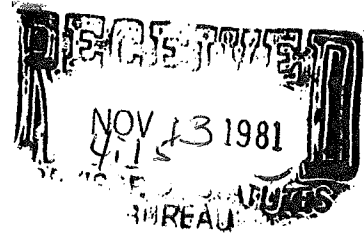

ORDER OF THE DEPARTMENT OF EMPLOYE TRUST FUNDS GROUP INSURANCE BOARD

REPEALING RULES

Relating to the transmission of premiums for group life insurance from annuitants
of the Wisconsin Retirement System.

Analysis Prepared by the Department of Employee Trust Funds

This order is a housekeeping type of action repealing rules that have become redundant due to the creation of ETF 4.02 (1) (f), Wis. Adm. Code. Reporting standards of the Department of Employee Trust Funds such as these which interpret s. 40.15 (1), Stats., have been centralized in Chapter ETF 4 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code.


Pursuant to authority vested in the Group Insurance Board by s. 40.10 (2) (a), Stats., the Group Insurance Board repeals rules interpreting s. 40.15 (1), Stats., as follows:

- SECTION 1. Chapter Grp 4 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is repealed.
SECTION 2. Chapter Grp 12 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is repealed.

The repeals contained in this order shall take effect as provided in s. 227.026 (1) (intro.), Stats.


Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

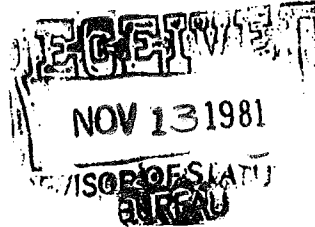
